Make sure you have put mail@flocknote.com on your contacts FIRST to ensure that the messages from mail@flocknote.com do not ever end up in SPAM or Junk mail.

Next go to flocknote.com in your browser. Click the [Reset or create password](#) link. Once you select a password, you will have an email from Flock Note in your inbox. Follow the directions on that email.

Once you have logged in you can go to the Edit Profile option towards the top. Here you can verify your information etc. There is the basic profile which gives your name, email address and phone number. At the top you will see a tab named St. John Neumann. Here you can put other information which you want, such as birthday, sacraments received, etc.
